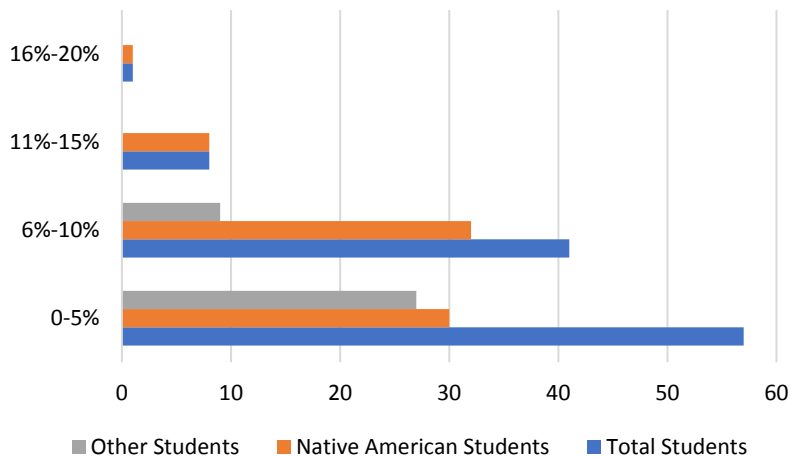
### 6th - 12th Student Population for the 2017-2018 School Year

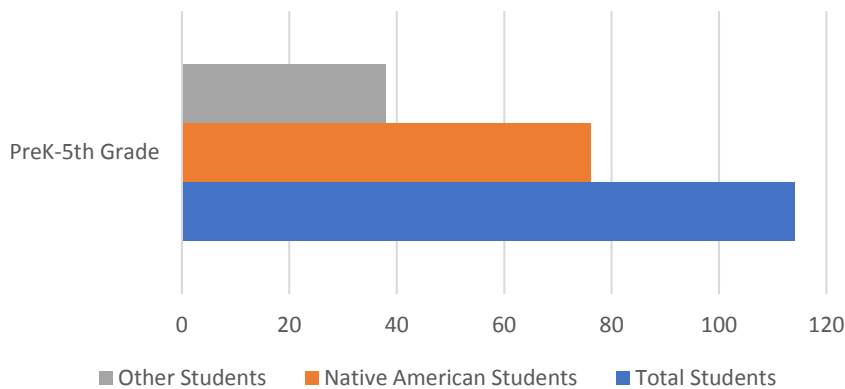

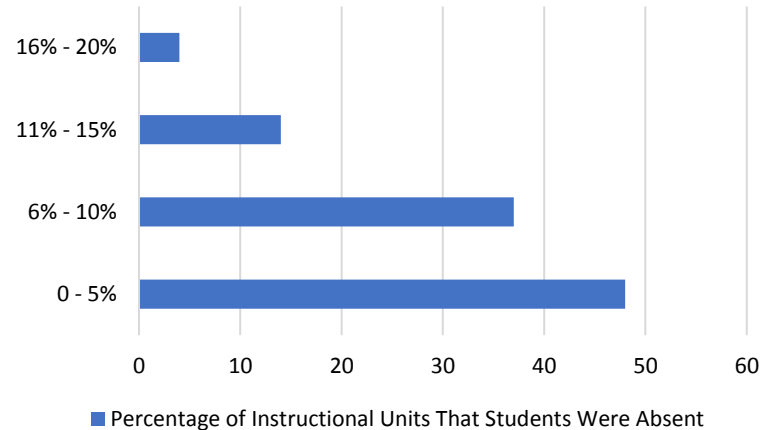

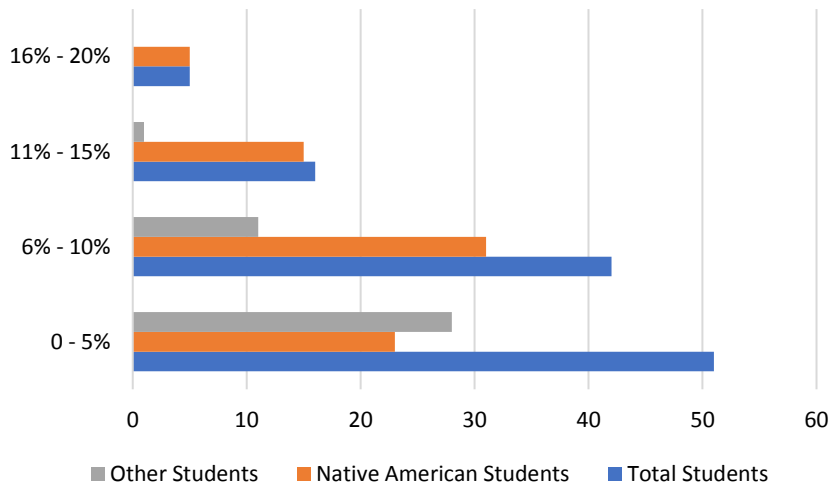
### PreK - 5th Student Population for the 2017-2018 School Year

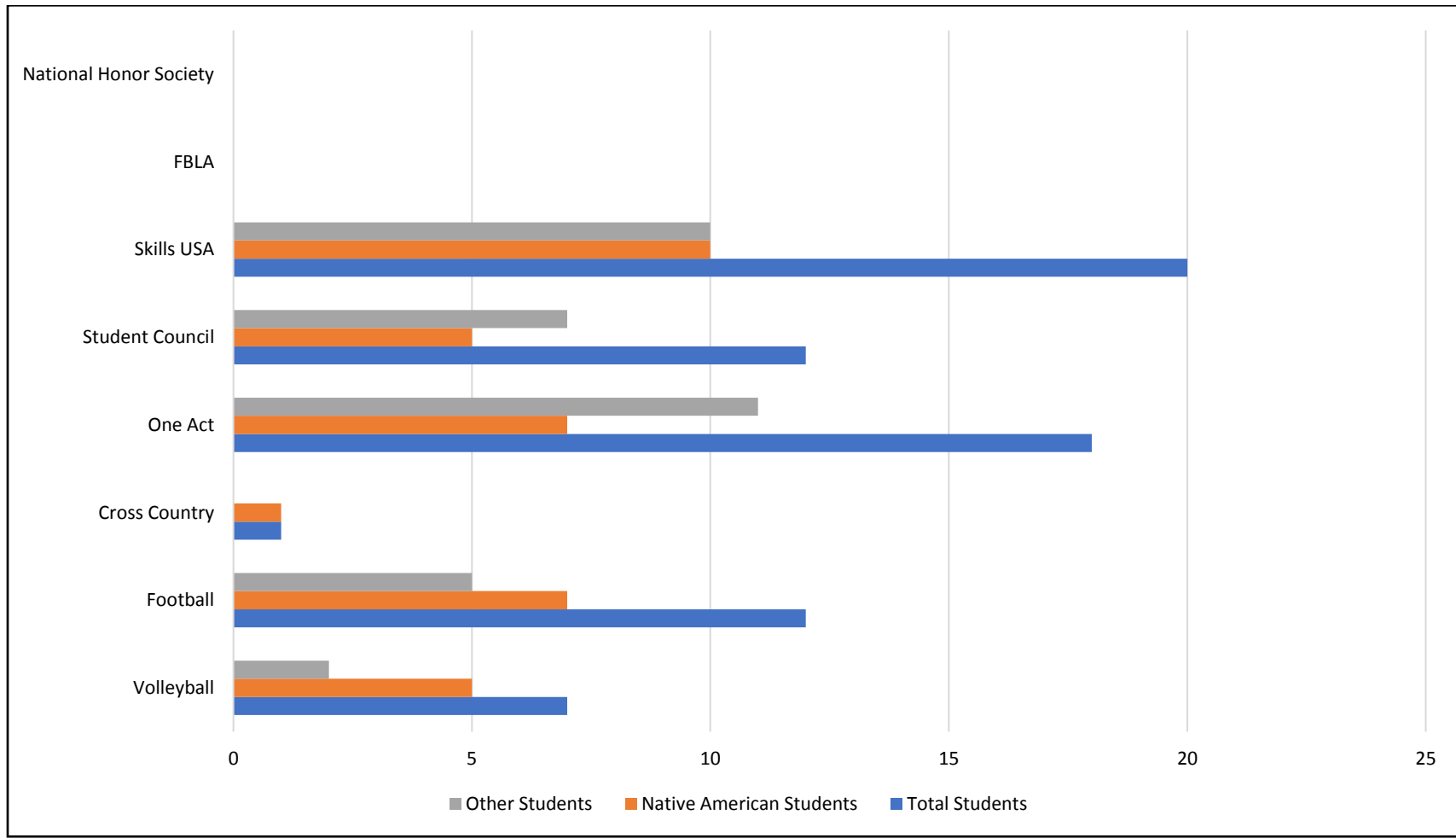

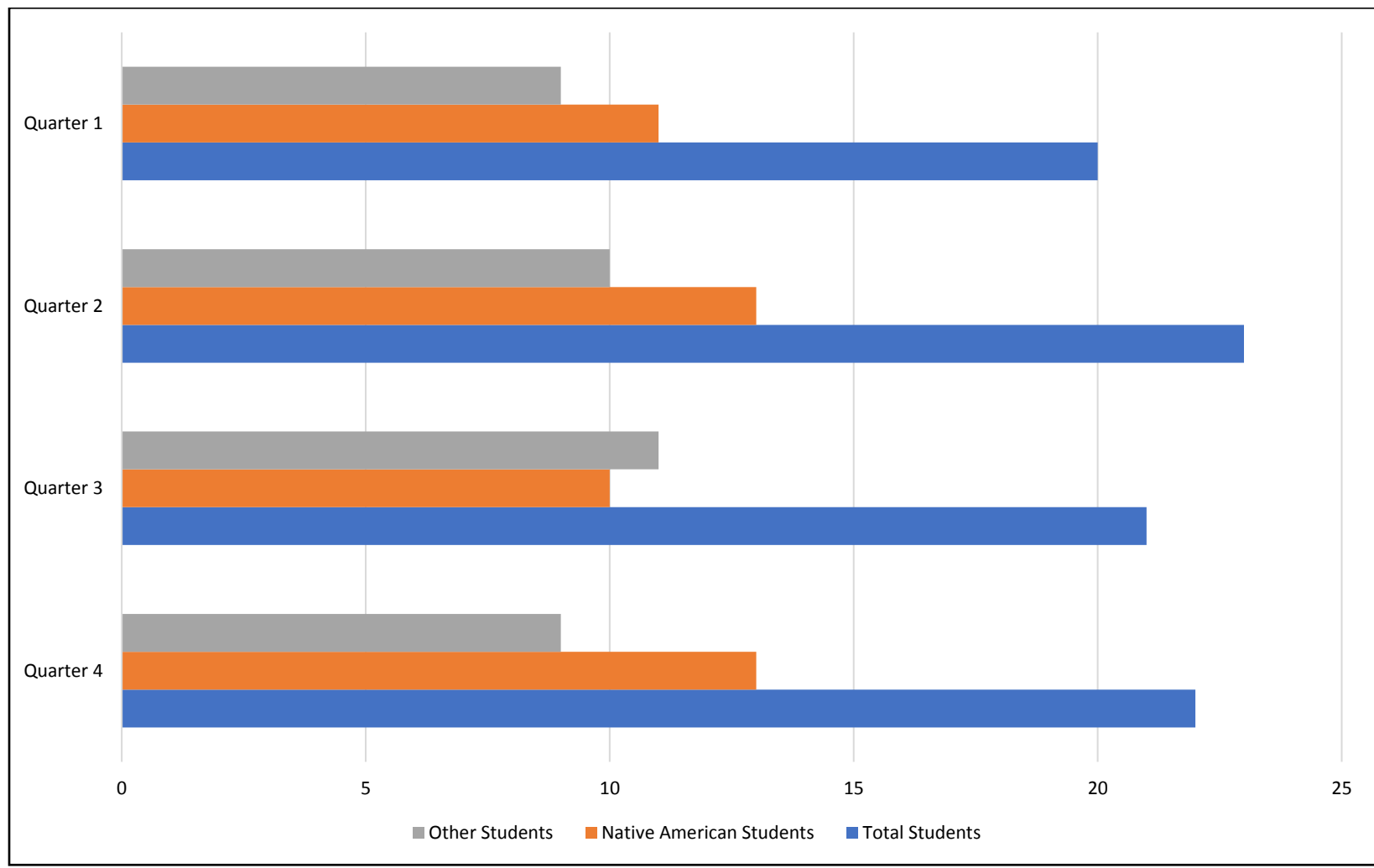
